

The Activity Card for adult refugees

June 1st - September 30th 2022



The Activity Card is for adult refugees living in emergency accommodation in Bergen. The card gives you free entry to a number of leisure activities. In this brochure, you will find an overview. You can, for example, travel to Kvamskogen to stay in a cabin, bring a friend to a concert, learn to play an instrument or visit one of the city's museums. No matter what you choose, we hope that this card brings you joy, and a lot of good experiences.

Rules for using the card:

- The card lasts four months - from June 1st to September 30th 2022.
- The card is personal, only you can use it.
- The card gives you two tickets for each activity/event, so that you can bring a friend or a family member.

How many times can I visit?

- AdO Arena: a maximum of eight times during the card's validity period.
- Bergen Kino (cinema): once per month, and a maximum of four times during the card's validity period.
- Soltun cabin: can be rented for free maximum 48 hours (two nights)
- All other places: you can visit as many times as you want, during the card's validity period.

Please note that some of the activities have a limited amount of tickets available. Changes in the program may occur.
